The Improvement Examinations for the ICSE (Class X) will be conducted from **6<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> October 2020**

The Improvement Examinations for the ISC (Class XII) will be conducted on **6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> October 2020**

through their school. On receipt of the same, the revised Statement of Marks and Pass Certificate will be sent to the candidates' school.

Candidates who are unsuccessful in the Compartmental Examination and do not qualify for the award of a Pass Certificate, must also return their original Statement of Marks to the Council through their school and will be issued a revised Statement of Marks which will reflect the updated result of the candidate as per the Council's record.

## **7. Issue of Statement of Marks and Pass Certificates – Improvement Examination**

Those candidates who had appeared for the Improvement Examination in specific subject/paper(s) and who have been awarded changed marks, must return the previous Statement of Marks/Pass Certificates in original to the Council through their school. On receipt of the same the revised Statement of Marks/Pass Certificates will be sent to the candidates' school. These marks will reflect the updated marks of the candidate in the subject/paper(s) for which he/she appeared as per the Council's record. **The marks obtained by the candidates in the Improvement Examination(s) shall be considered as their final marks.**

## **8. Unsuccessful / Absent candidates at the Compartmental Examination:**

Those candidates who are not successful or are absent at the Compartmental Examination:

- May re-appear for the ICSE / ISC Examinations in the following Year 2021 Examination.
- In the said Examination, the candidate will be required to re-appear in all the subjects for which he/she is registered.
- These candidates will need to follow the Regulations & Syllabuses and textbooks prescribed for the concerned Year's Examination.

## **9. Those candidates who are absent at the Improvement Examination:**

For those candidates who are absent for the Improvement Examination, there is no provision for the same to be held later. The imputed marks awarded to them will remain unchanged.

## **Important Instructions to be strictly followed by the candidates appearing for the Examinations**

1. Candidates must reach the examination centre well ahead of time to ensure staggered movement and smooth entry to avoid overcrowding.
